

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

About the works	
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What is the Grey Street Improvement works?	The Grey Street Improvement Project will deliver important safety improvements for all road users and pedestrians, as well as improve the streetscape along the median of Grey Street.
	The works will take place between Vulture Street and Russell Street.
	The project will deliver upgrades to road median crossings, roadway and footpath lighting and landscaping, as well as upgrades to footpaths to relevel uneven surfaces, remove trip hazards and damaged tree grates.
Why is there a need for these works to happen?	To maintain and improve the safety of pedestrians who use this section of Grey Street.
	The works will also improve the streetscape along the median of Grey Street making it a safer and more welcoming street.
How will the works be delivered?	The works will be delivered in four stages. Stages 1 – 4.
About Stage 3	
What is the location of Stage 3 works?	Stage 3 works is the section of Grey Street, including the centre median and footpaths, between Glenelg and Russell Streets.
When will Stage 3 works take place?	Works commence on Monday 12 June and will be completed by Friday 30 June, weather permitting.
What will stage 3 works include?	Stage 3 works will include:
	 median landscaping median lighting install replacement of tree light fittings rectification works along sections of footpath outside retail tenancies, including the relevelling of the footpath.
When will the footpath upgrade be undertaken?	 Rectification works along sections of footpath outside retail tenancies on Grey Street (including the relevelling of the footpath) will be undertaken after Stage 4, at the end of the improvement works.

What are the standard construction hours?	Project works are scheduled to take place Monday to Friday, 6am to 3pm (no weekend nor night works).
	It is an SBC requirement that there will be no noisy works between 12pm and 2pm.

There will be periods of noisy works when the existing concrete footpath needs to be cut for safe removal. Expect to hear saw cutting (wet, to ensure minimal dust) and jack hammering.
