


Grey Street Improvement Works: Stage 1 Monday 17 April – Friday 19 May 2023

As part of the Grey Street Improvement works, South Bank Corporation will undertake important upgrade works to Grey Street between Tribune Street and Ernest Street (weather and construction conditions permitting).

These works are the first to occur as part of a four-stage program of works. Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience and cooperation while we work to deliver these important safety improvements for all road users and pedestrians, as well as improve the overall streetscape of Grey Street.

WHEN:	From Monday 17 April – Friday 19 May 2023 6am – 3pm, Monday to Friday daily (weekdays only, no weekend/night works)
WHERE:	Grey Street, between Tribune Street and Ernest Street
WORKS WILL INVOLVE:	 Median lighting: replacement of street lights in the centre median, installation of uplights at the base of each Kauri Pine tree in the centre median. Landscaping: dedicated pedestrian crossing paths, irrigation and planting of new sub-tropical plants within the road median. Footpath: upgrades to sections of footpath outside retail tenancies (Shysh, Bourbon St / Harajuku, and Bake N Grill) to relevel uneven surfaces and remove trip hazards.
IMPACTS:	 Traffic Control: South bound temporary lane closures, changes to traffic flow via detours and short-term traffic disruptions are expected (see details below). Traffic controllers will be on site at all time. Noise: Nearby residents and businesses may experience some noise associated with the construction activity, machinery and truck movements. Access: South Bank Carpark, resident and visitor access to retail tenancies will remain open at all times during the works, with pedestrian detours in place where needed to allow for footpath works to take place. Clear signage will be in place at all times.
ROAD CLOSURES to assist with construction works occurring:	 Grey Street south bound lane will be closed to traffic between Tribune St and Ernest St - detour via Little Stanley Street. Some service vehicles permitted by Traffic Controller (i.e., waste and emergency vehicles, New Performing Arts Venue trucks). Grey Street north bound lane to remain open at all times.
