Retail Precinct Round Up

Awnings - Let there be shade!

Commencing in February 2017, the Corporation will be installing new awnings along Little Stanley Street and re-skinning existing awnings to provide additional weather protection for retailers and customers, while also acting as noise mitigation barriers for residential balconies above. These awnings will be similar to the newer awnings that have been erected along Little Stanley Street over the past two years.

Retailer News

Several exciting retail fit outs and new retailer openings on Little Stanley Street will commence from January 2017.

South Bank Corporation is looking forward to welcoming 'Junk', an Asian street food concept that will occupy the retail space formerly occupied by 'Ginga'.

Japanese fast food-style 'Suki Sushi Burrito' will open in the former space occupied by 'Dell Ugo' and will be accessed from Grey Street.

'Malt Traders' which currently operates in Brisbane's CBD will open a boutique bottle shop featuring craft beers, bio dynamic and organic wines, single malt whiskies along with chartreuse plates and small food offers. Malt Traders will operate from the site previously occupied by 'Movenpick'.

South Bank's popular 'Baba Ganouj' is currently in the process of expanding into a larger retail space formerly occupied by 'La Via' on Little Stanley Street and will be broadening its Lebanese café menu to include an authentic Lebanese restaurant menu.
