<b>Details of the work</b>	<p>Remediation works to remove trip hazards caused by tree grates.</p> <p>Removal of existing tree grate finish (ie concrete cutting) and releveling of new stone set / porous pavement.</p> <p>Indicative methodology includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Securing of tree grate with appropriate temporary fencing and barriers.</li> <li>- Removal of existing tree grate material through manual labour and vacuum excavation.</li> <li>- Concrete removal around the tree (concrete cutting and jackhammering).</li> <li>- Horticultural care (including fertiliser and soil, etc.) and inspection of tree health.</li> <li>- Installation of new tree grate material (porous pavement / stone set).</li> <li>- Setting time prior to temporary fencing removed.</li> </ul>

	<b>Details:</b> Small areas of footpath will be closed to pedestrians. Temporary fencing with scrim will be installed around the work zone, along with work

	zone/pedestrian signage.
<b>Will there be any detours/traffic impacts/road closures?</b>	No – no road closures are required for these works.
	<b>Details:</b> There will be some requirement for work trucks to occupy a carpark or loading zone directly adjacent to the work zone for a period of time.
<b>Will there be any areas closed to pedestrians or cyclists?</b>	Pedestrians will be managed and directed away from the work site around a safe exclusion zone. Temporary fencing will be installed.

<b>Will there be noise (type and level)?</b>	Yes Vacuum Excavation – idle truck noise is expected during the excavation of existing tree grate debris and soil around the tree.  Concrete cutting - loud noise is expected during the demolition and removal of the existing tree grates. Noise includes concrete cutting and jackhammering. Loud noise is expected periodically, 1-2 hours per tree grate.
